

# The McLymont Creek Scholarship



The McLymont Creek Scholarship is open to members of the Tahltan Nation who are Grade 12 graduates, university students, or adults who wish to pursue post-secondary education to advance their careers.

## Scholarship

One single or multiple scholarships are available for the 2018 academic year.

- One single or multiple academic scholarships up to a combined maximum of \$20,000 is available for the 2019 academic year for degree or trade, certificate diploma programs at accredited post-secondary institutions.
- The McLymont Creek Scholarship began in 2015 and is available each year thereafter for 59 years.
- If in any year the funds are not disbursed, the unused funds will be carried over for awarding multiple scholarships in subsequent years.

## Eligibility

Applicants are eligible for the McLymont Creek Scholarship if:

- They are a member of the Tahltan Nation.
- They are enrolled in post-secondary education in British Columbia, Alberta, and the Yukon Territory unless an institute in a different location is agreed to by the scholarship committee.
- They are enrolled in a trade or skill development program through a post-secondary institution or accredited program.
- Applicants are required to provide confirmation of Tahltan ancestry.

## Criteria

Applicants must provide a brief summary from the points listed below in the application.

- Tahltan ancestry
- Academic achievement
- Community involvement
- Letter of intent
- Program costs, budget and funding sources
- Letter of recommendation

A selection committee will review all applications to determine award recipients.
