## COVID-19 Update #10 – Use of masks & temp checks while travelling

Red Chris has implemented the mandatory use of masks while travelling to and from site where physical distancing may not be reasonably achievable. This directive will reduce the likelihood of people who may be a carrier of the virus but has not shown symptoms, from transmitting COVID-19 to others within 1-2 meters.

Everyone will be supplied with a mask, and due to global supply chain disruptions and priority of supply to medical staff treating high-risk patients, we ask that you extend the use of your mask for up to 5 times, under the following circumstances:

- Not contaminated by blood, respiratory or nasal secretion, or other bodily fluid
- Not been in contact with someone with cold and flu symptoms
- Stored in a breathable bag (paper bag) which is regularly replaced
- You have avoided touching the inside of the mask
- The mask is not damaged, hard to breathe through, torn, or otherwise showing signs of deformity

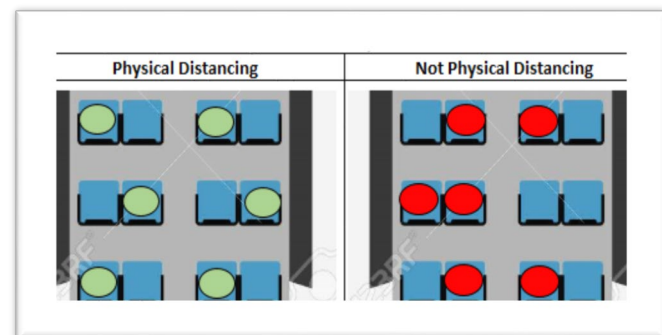
Extended-use masks must only be used for Bus and Airplane travel due to the low risk of contact transmission. Please label the bag or mask to ensure personal use only. If labelling the mask, only place markings on the strap.

### Plane travel – effective 23 March 2020

- All passengers prior to boarding will be provided with a face mask to worn for the whole flight and not removed, except for the purposes of drinking. The flight crew will advise when the masks can be removed.
- All passengers will be temperature checked at the airline gate prior to boarding. Anyone with a temperature of over 38 degrees will NOT be permitted to board and asked to return home and seek medical advice.

### Bus travel – effective 23 March 2020

- There will be a limit of two passengers per row of 4 seats. We will be running additional buses to accommodate this change as necessary
- If the number of passengers does not permit segregation, all passengers prior to boarding must wear their face mask for the bus trip and not remove it, except for the purposes of drinking.
