COVID-19 Update #9

We continue to implement the precautionary measures to prevent the transmission of COVID-19 at our Red Chris operation, and stay in close contact with our community partners and neighboring operations.

We thank everyone for their support and commitment in following the safe hygiene practices and this collective effort is keeping us all safe and healthy.

At this stage we do not have any confirmed cases of COVID-19 from Red Chris. We are waiting for the results from our employee who was tested last week, they have been discharged from hospital and are currently recovering in self-isolation. We have also been informed of a second employee who has undergone testing as a precaution. We will update you with the results of both tests as soon as we are informed.

The Northwest Territories (NWT) chief public officer has also announced plans to restricting travel into the territory in an effort to stall transmission of COVID-19, with limited exceptions. NWT travel will be prohibited to all travelers with the exception of:

- NWT residents,
- Import/export workers (e.g. supply chain transportation services for food, equipment, fuel, or other goods into the territory, movers and carriers, and workers that support the supply chain industry),
- Flight crews,
- Medical Travel patients from Kitikmeot,
- Persons who support essential services (e.g. health care, law enforcement, and health or safety),
- Workers involved in the construction of GNWT capital infrastructure projects.
- Southern resident transient workers in the mineral and petroleum resources industry, and
- Persons who cross the NWT border while participating in traditional harvesting or on the land activities and who do not enter any communities as part of this

We are working with our employees and contractors who reside in the NWT to manage these restrictions.

We appreciate this is a difficult time, please remember you can contact our Employee Assistance Program any time to talk about your concerns and gain professional advice.

Also please remember to stay safe and stay focused and stop the job immediately if you don't feel safe or have concerns.
