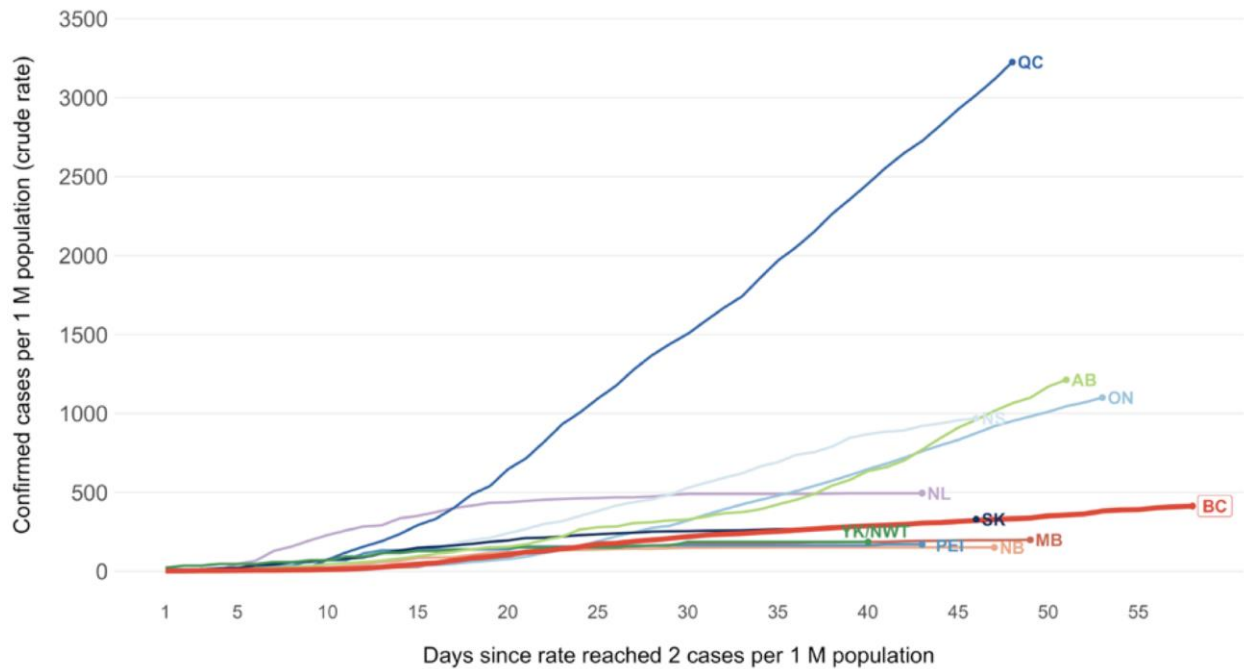

## LATEST ADVICE AND MEASURES IN BRITISH COLUMBIA

- The Government of British Columbia has announced that British Columbians whose ability to work has been affected because of the COVID-19 pandemic and are receiving the Canada Emergency Response Benefit (CERB) can now apply for the B.C. Emergency Benefit for Workers (BCEBW) online.<sup>5</sup>
  - The BCEBW is a one-time, tax-free payment of \$1,000 for eligible British Columbians.
  - To be eligible for the BCEBW, people must:
    - Have been a resident of B.C. on March 15, 2020;
    - Meet the eligibility requirements for the CERB;
    - Have been approved for the CERB, even if a federal benefit payment has not yet been received;
    - Be at least 15 years old on the date of application;
    - Have filed, or agree to file, a 2019 B.C. income tax return; and
    - Not be receiving provincial income assistance or disability assistance.

### Terrace

- No significant updates from the City of Terrace.

### Smithers

- No significant updates from the Town of Smithers.

## LATEST ADVICE AND MEASURES IN YUKON TERRITORY

- Yukon’s Chief Medical Officer of Health Dr. Brendan Hanley has the following updates for the Yukon public on measures being taken in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.<sup>6</sup>
  - All of the 11 people who have contracted COVID-19 in Yukon have recovered.
  - There are no active cases in the territory.
  - We have traced each case in Yukon so far to its origin which means there continues to be no known community spread in the territory.
  - Yukon’s hospitals will, on a limited basis, increase some elective and non-urgent services that were temporarily suspended over the last month.
    - The services include elective surgeries and non-urgent bloodwork, x-rays, imaging tests, physiotherapy, occupational therapy and appointments with visiting specialists.
    - Hospitals will provide all of these resumed services by appointment only.

### Whitehorse

- No significant updates from the City of Whitehorse.

### Watson Lake

- No COVID-19 information for this community is currently available.
