LATEST ADVICE AND MEASURES IN YUKON TERRITORY

- Today, under the guidance of Yukon’s Chief Medical Officer of Health, the Yukon Government announced that the Yukon is on track to allow face-to-face classes for Kindergarten to grade 12 schools for the 2020-21 school year.⁵
 - Yukon’s health and safety guidelines will be developed before the start of the 2020-21 school year.
 - Inline with the guidelines, each school principal and staff will:
 - Determine how it will adjust its operation to meet the unique needs of the school communities.
 - Share its adjusted operations with parents, staff, and students before the start of the 2020-21 school year.

LATEST ADVICE AND MEASURES FROM THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA

- Today, Canada’s Minister of Agriculture and Agri-Food announced the launch of the second call for proposals under the Local Food Infrastructure fund, valued at \$43.4 million. ⁶ The purpose of this initiative is to strengthen food security during the COVID-19 pandemic.
 - This fund aims to:
 - Strengthen food support organizations
 - Help to improve access to safe and nutritious food for Canadians at risk
 - The call for proposals under this program will support:
 - Small and large community-led projects at facilities such as urban gardens, community kitchens, food banks, and greenhouses.
 - Organizations who are ready to enhance their regional food systems.
 - Of note:
 - Applications will be accepted on a continuous basis until funding has been allocated.
 - Projects valued at up to \$250,000 will be accepted
- Today, the Government of Canada announced the launch of a new “web hub” to give organizations access to reliable resources and information on how to properly buy and sell personal protective equipment (PPE) during the pandemic. ⁷
 - This “web hub” provides:
 - Canadian organizations with federal, provincial, territorial information and resources about PPE
 - Buyers with PPE supplier lists
 - Buyers with guidance to help plan purchases
