SUBJECT: PRETIVM COVID-19 UPDATE

DATE: JANUARY 8, 2021

In follow-up to the previous announcement on January 3rd, 2021, please be advised that there have been no additional cases of COVID-19 reported at the Brucejack Mine. The one individual that previously tested positive is now asymptomatic, is in good health and remains in isolation at the Brucejack Mine main camp. A thorough contact tracing process was conducted in partnership with Northern Health to determine the potential for additional exposures. Those limited close contacts identified are asymptomatic and will remain in quarantine at Brucejack for the duration established by Northern Health.

Pretium continues to follow the stringent COVID-19 infection prevention guidance and directives of federal, provincial and regional authorities in respect of general and mine site-specific protocols. It is mandatory that all Brucejack personnel follow the site regulations in accordance with the authorities' standards. These on-site regulations include daily self-assessment, wearing masks in all common areas and while in transit to site, and maintaining six (6) feet (2 meters) of social distance from others at all times. Pretium's Camp Services team is meeting and surpassing the recommendations provided by the Northern Health Authority and the BC Center for Disease Control's guidance and updates. On-site medical staff including remote-care nurses and advanced-care paramedics under the guidance of two off-site physicians from Iridia Medical continue to manage the operational COVID-19 response at Brucejack.

The health and safety of our workforce and surrounding communities remains our top priority and Pretium will continue to do everything within our ability to protect our people and those in neighbouring communities. Pretium will continue to provide regular updates going forward.
