Summary: The Tahltan Central Government Fisheries Department is looking for field technicians to assist us in various fisheries projects, including fish sampling and enumeration, fish habitat assessments, monitoring, and studies within the Stikine watershed.

Responsibilities:

- Perform all duties and responsibilities in accordance with TCG's policies and procedures
- Collect biological samples and data as directed
- Maintain safety on worksite
- Maintain field camp and equipment
- Other duties as directed by supervisor

Qualifications and Requirements:

- Level 1 First Aid with Transport Endorsement
- Any formal training or relevant certifications, Diploma or Degrees in Natural Resources or Wildlife Management
- Class 5 Driver's license
- PAL (Firearms Possession and Acquisition License)

Personal Skills and Attributes:

- Fisheries experience preferred but not required
- Ability to work well with others
- Able to work in remote field camps
- Great problem-solving skills
- Excellent communication (verbal and technical writing) skills and time management

- Good physical ability (as work can be physically demanding)
- Be comfortable working around wild animals (bears, moose, etc.)

Remuneration and Work Hours:

- Pay is based on an experience scale and a daily rate (New hires \$201/day)
- Hours vary depending on project and site location

Work location: Works may be conducted in the Telegraph Creek area, and/or one of the various remote field and satellite camps throughout the Tahltan Territory.
