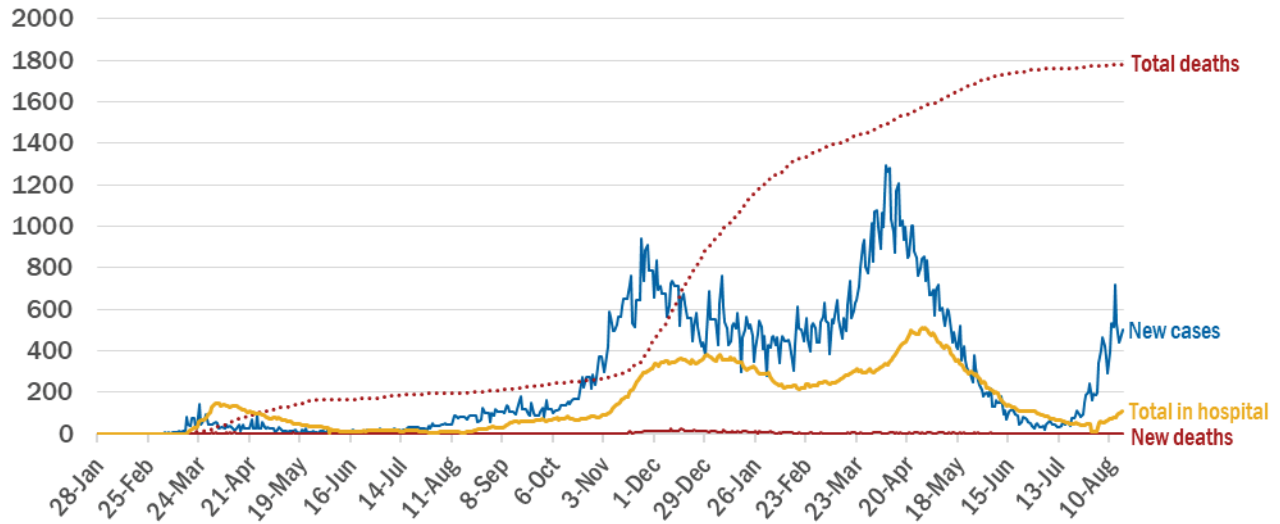

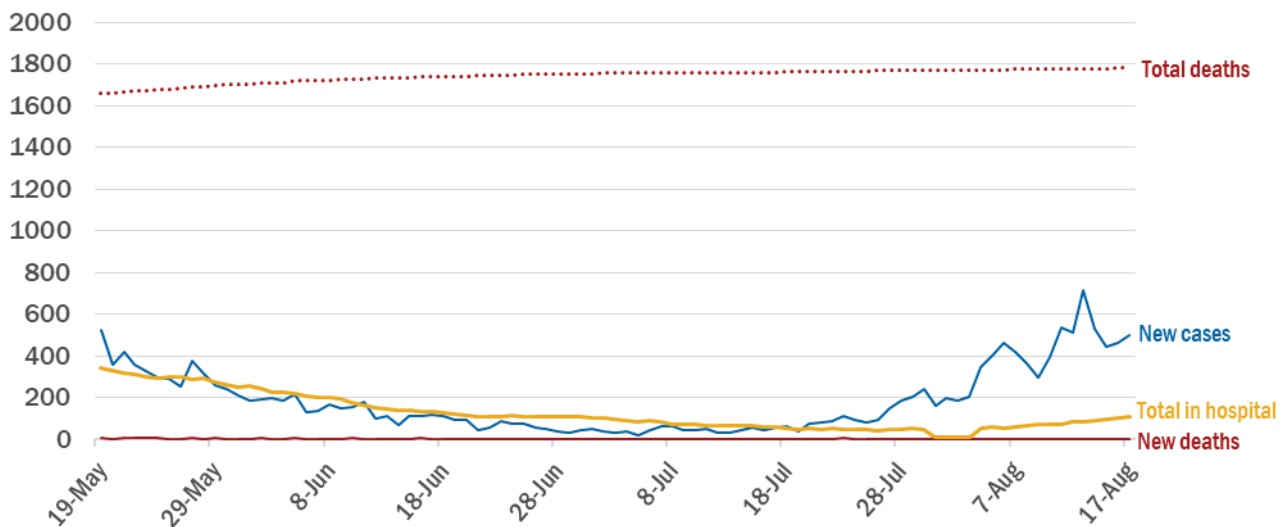

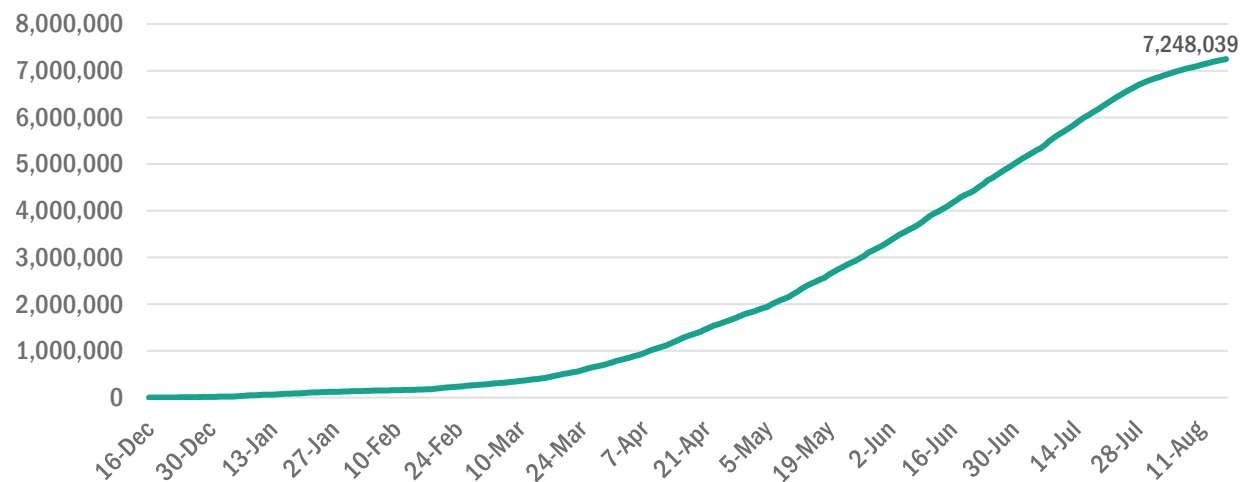

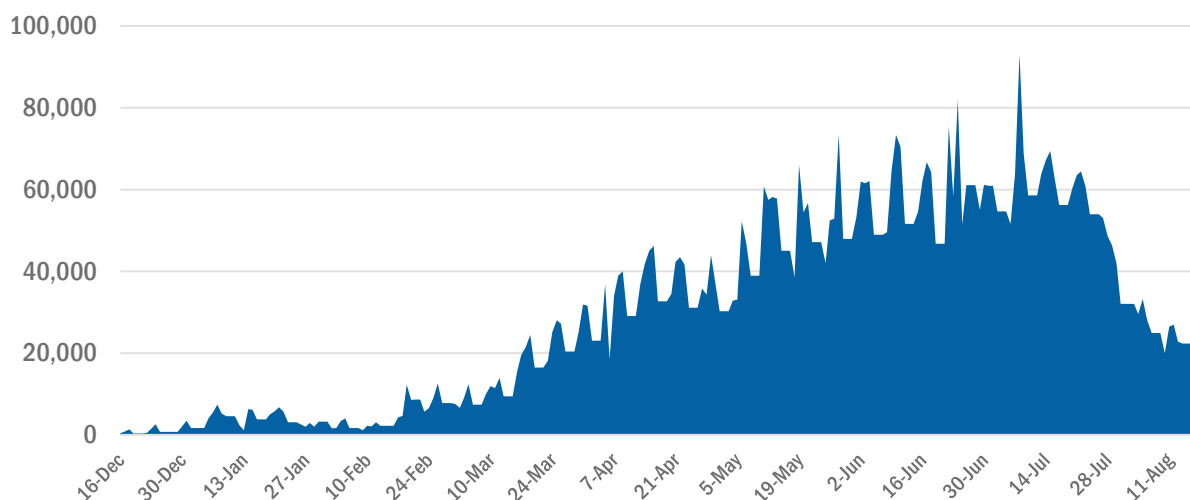

SIGNIFICANT UPDATES IN THE YUKON TERRITORY

- Today, Dr. Catherine Elliott, Yukon’s acting Chief Medical Officer of Health, reported 13 new cases of COVID-19 from 12 p.m. Friday, August 13, to 12 p.m. today.⁵
 - Of these cases, 7 are in Whitehorse and 6 are in rural Yukon.
 - Anyone experiencing symptoms in Whitehorse should call the COVID-19 Testing and Assessment Centre at 867-393-3083 or book online to arrange for testing.
 - People in communities should contact their rural community health centre.

SIGNIFICANT UPDATES FROM THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA

- *A federal election was called on August 14, 2021 and scheduled for September 20, 2021; updates from the Government of Canada during this period may be limited and at a reduced frequency.*
- No significant updates from the Government of Canada.
