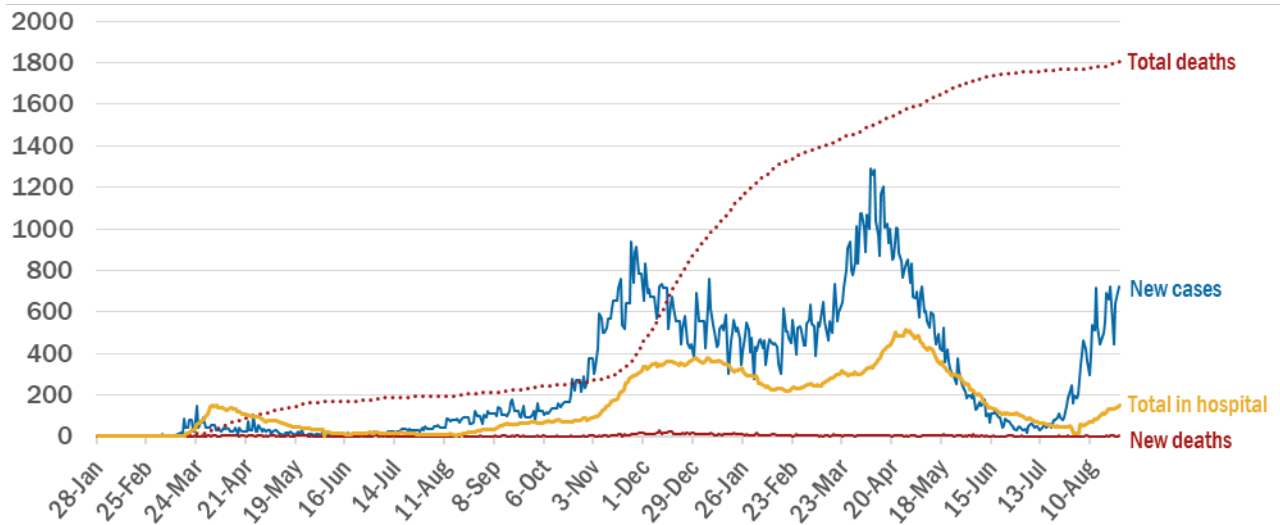

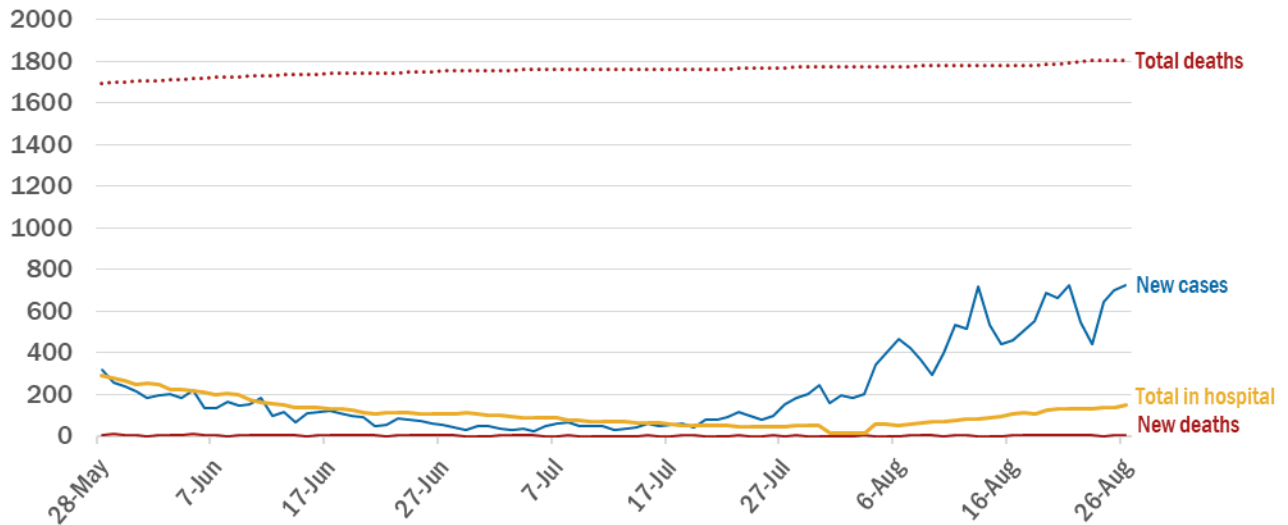

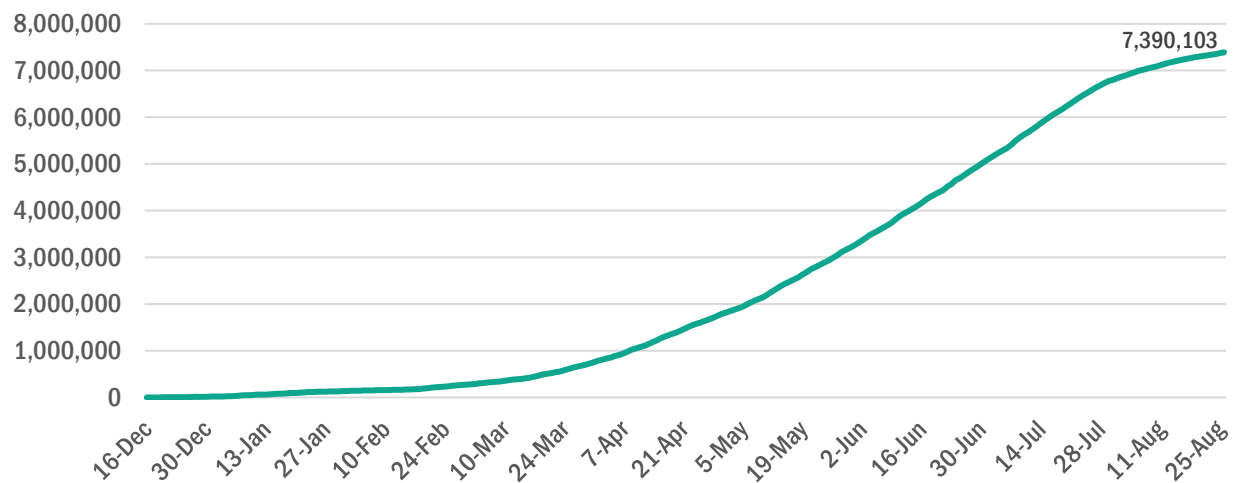

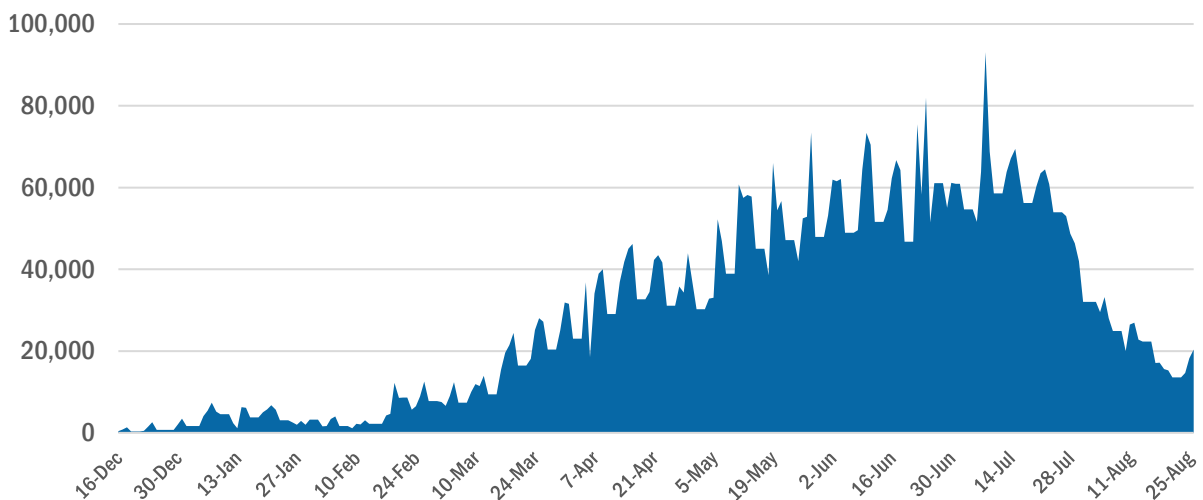

## **SIGNIFICANT UPDATES IN THE YUKON TERRITORY**

- Today, the Government of Yukon shared survey feedback from students, families and school staff about their perspectives and experiences on learning, health and safety, and mental health during the last half of the 2020-2021 school year<sup>5</sup>. Highlights include the following:
  - “Among key findings from the recent survey, most students, families, and school staff said they feel safe and informed when asked about the health and safety measures at their school.”
  - “The feedback from this survey will support student learning throughout the 2021–22 school year and the ongoing response to COVID-19.”
  - “The results will also help increase awareness and accessibility of mental health and wellness supports for students, families and school staff across the Yukon.”

## **SIGNIFICANT UPDATES FROM THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA**

- *A federal election was called on August 14<sup>th</sup>, and scheduled for September 20<sup>th</sup>; updates from the Government of Canada during this period may be limited and at a reduced frequency.*
- No significant updates from the Government of Canada.
