Tahltan Land Stewardship Plan (TSLP) **Expression of Interest: Stewardship Planning Advisory Committee**

Summary: Under the Tahltan Stewardship Initiative ("TSI") the Tahltan Central Government ("TCG") is continuing the work to develop a Tahltan Land Stewardship Plan ("TLSP") for the Tahltan Nation's Territory. The TLSP is a planning tool that identifies the Tahltan community's vision for the care of Tahltan land and resources. The plan provides land stewardship direction in the form of principles, goals, objectives, and constraints that will guide how land, water, wildlife, fish, and natural resources are used in Tahltan Territory. It will also provide a basis for decision making around proposed land use in Tahltan Territory and will support Tahltans to fulfil our inherent stewardship responsibility to our Territory based on our stewardship vision and principles.

The TLSP process will involve extensive engagement so that all Tahltan members have an opportunity to participate in making recommendations for decisions that affect them. A Stewardship Planning Advisory Committee is being established to provide opportunities for more in-depth input from Tahltan Elders, Youth, and community experts into our Land Stewardship Planning.

The Committee's mandate is to:

- a) make recommendations and provide advice to the TLSP Working Group about the current and future desired stewardship of Tahltan land, water, fish wildlife and natural resources as it relates to the creation and implementation of the TLSP;
- b) to advise and support the TLSP Working Group and assist in the championing of the TLSP and TLSP planning processes.



The Committee is open to TCG Members and will be made up of individuals representing a range of interests and expertise from the Tahltan Nation. Principles for inclusion and diversity of the Committee are:

- Membership will aim to have a gender balance;
- Membership will include at least ½ who reside in, or grew up in, the Territory in addition to other Tahltan members who live outside of Territory; and,
- Membership is reflective of a diversity of Tahltan experience and technical expertise on the land and in Territory, community involvement, technical experience with matters related to land use and development.
