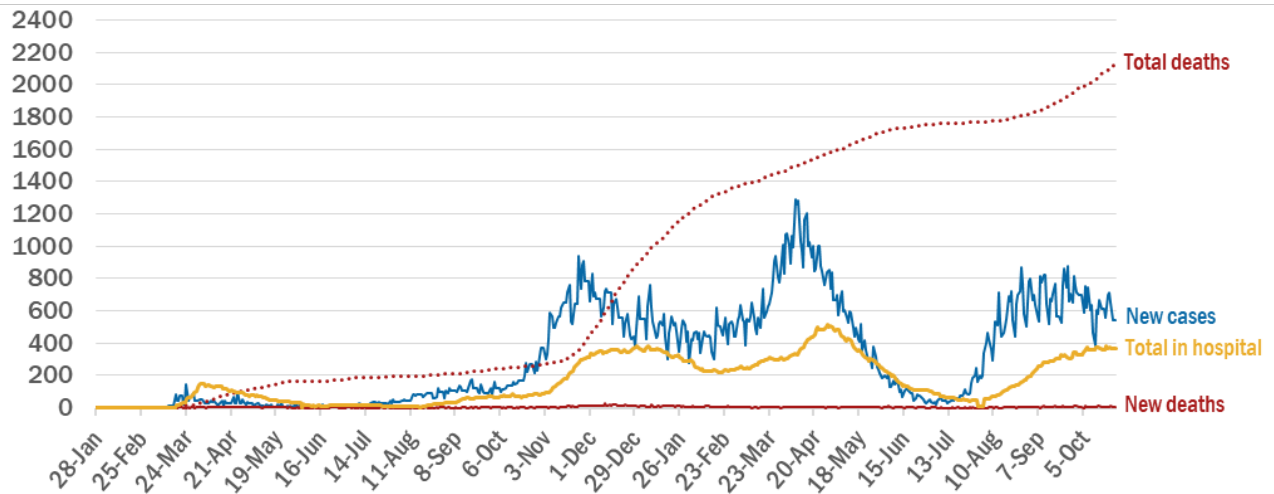

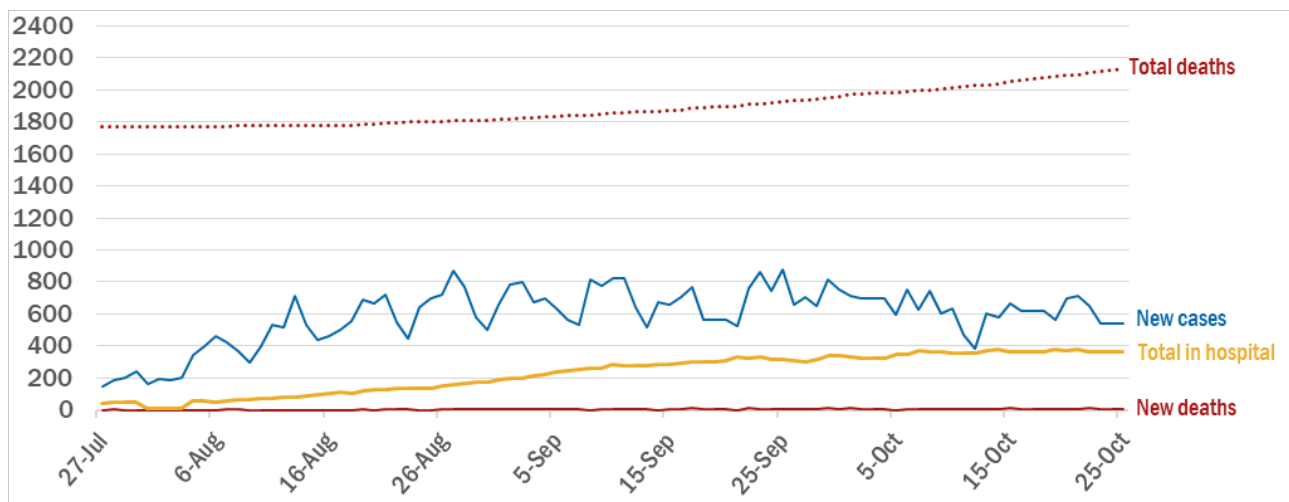

COVID-19 CASES AND DEATHS IN BC

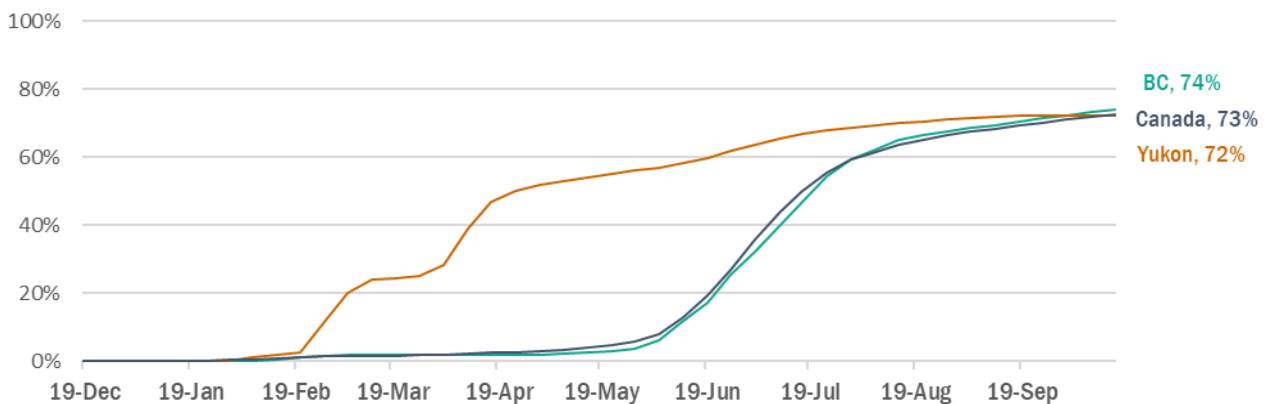

COVID-19 CASES AND DEATHS IN BC – PAST THREE MONTHS



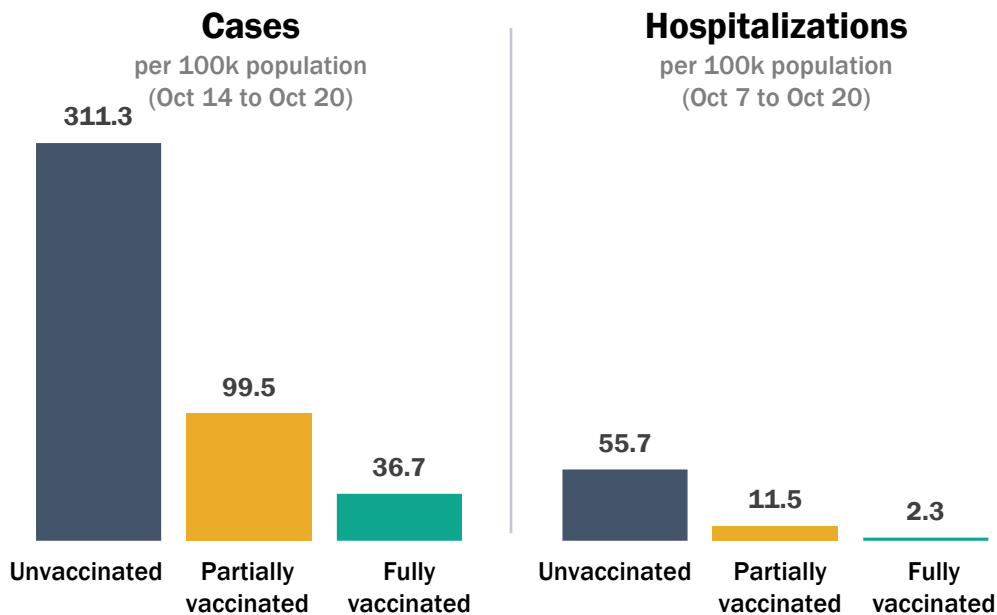
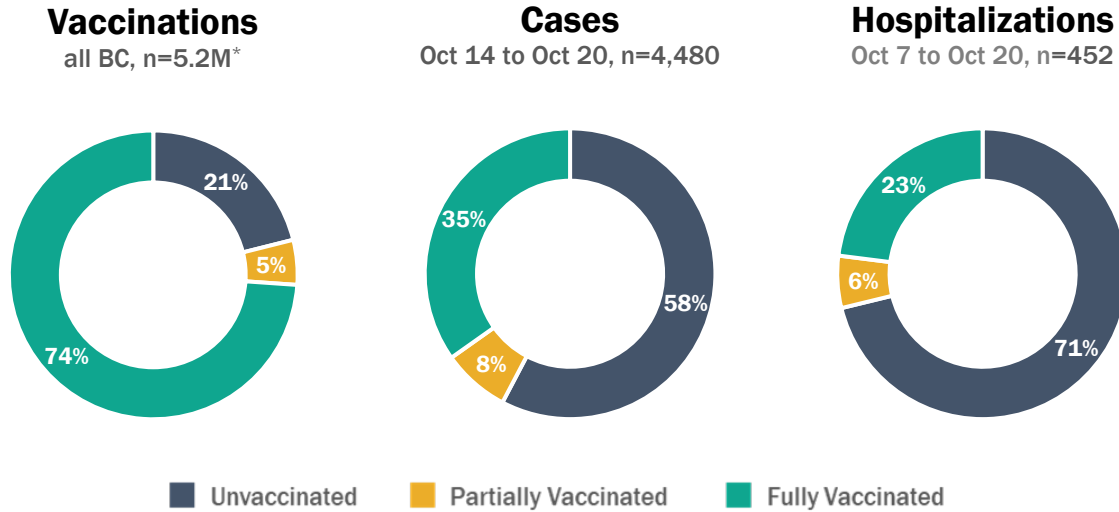
CUMULATIVE % OF PEOPLE FULLY VACCINATED WITH A COVID-19 VACCINE⁴

COVID-19 INFECTIONS IN B.C. BY VACCINATION STATUS

- From October 14 to October 20, 2021, people not fully vaccinated accounted for 65.2% of cases, and from October 7 to October 20, 2021, they accounted for 77.0% of hospitalizations.^{5,6}

SIGNIFICANT UPDATES IN BRITISH COLUMBIA

- Today, the First Nations Health Authority (FNHA) launched the youth-focused “Real Faces” vaccine campaign⁷. Highlights include the following:
 - “In an effort to connect with Indigenous people who are not yet vaccinated, the First Nations Health Authority is continuing to create public health awareness approaches to meet people where they are.”
 - FNHA staff who are actively involved in the pandemic response are part of the campaign.
 - The goal is to try and improve vaccine uptake and acceptance, as well as outcomes, for Indigenous people in B.C.
 - Everyone involved in the Real Faces campaign has been fully vaccinated.
 - The new campaign was developed with a specific focus on people aged 50 and under.
 - Youth in the 18-29 demographic currently have the lowest vaccination rates for both first and second doses.
 - Social media will be the primary pathway to reach target audiences.
 - Some print ads will appear in certain publications.
 - Posters will be distributed to First Nations communities throughout British Columbia.
