TAHLTAN NATION COVID-19 EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT UPDATE

The Tahltan Nation COVID-19 Emergency Management Team (TNCEMT) met again today and would like to inform the Tahltan Nation that 11 individuals are currently confirmed positive for COVID-19. Currently, 45 people have now been directed to isolate because they have been in direct contact with a COVID-19 positive case.

IMPORTANT REMINDER

To get this under control and limit the number of positive cases, everyone in Tahltan Territory needs to pull together and commit to the following effective immediately:

- **Limit your movements** to allow contact tracing to be completed;
- **Remain within your personal bubble**, unless you must go to work or you are going onto the land to exercise with those in your household (people you live with); avoid non-essential travel (masks, sanitizing and six feet distancing) if outside of your bubble;
- **Do not visit other communities; and**
- **If you have been in direct contact with anyone who has tested positive or is a confirmed positive you must self-isolate and self-monitor for 14 DAYS.** If you are employed in Territory, you must self-isolate and self-monitor for 14 DAYS. If you are employed outside of Territory or on-site in Territory, please contact your employer for direction.
- **If you have been identified as a "direct contact" with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 virus in any of our communities. IF you have been directed to self-isolate for 14 DAYS by either a Health professional or the contact tracer for EMC, you are required to self-isolate for 14 DAYS and self monitor for symptoms.**

Even if you are getting tested and the result is negative, you MUST self-isolate for 14 days, no exceptions.

Please be responsible and help keep our communities safe. Thanks for your cooperation and care for others.
