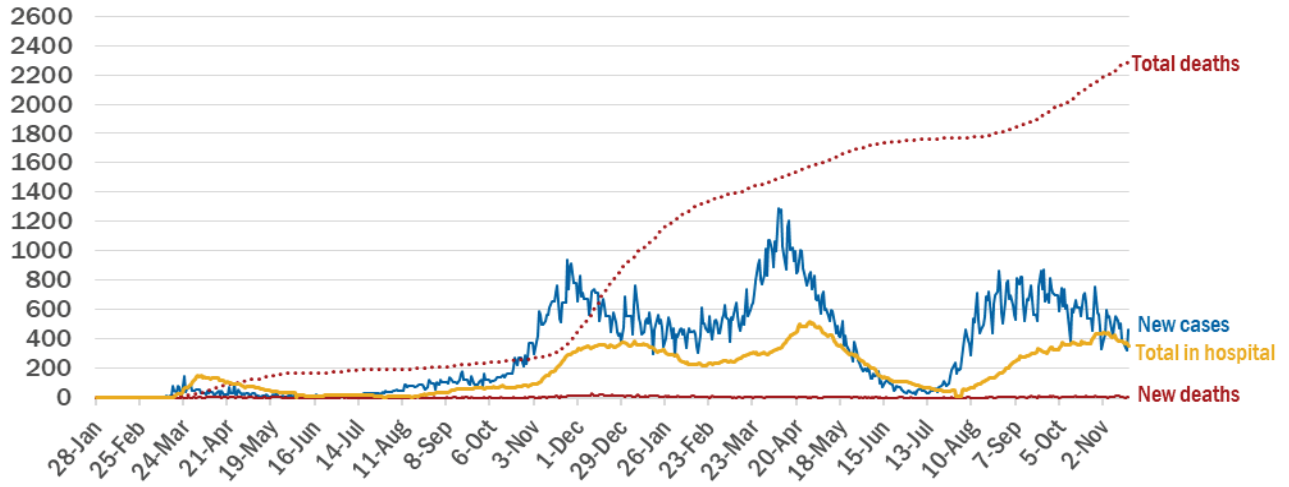

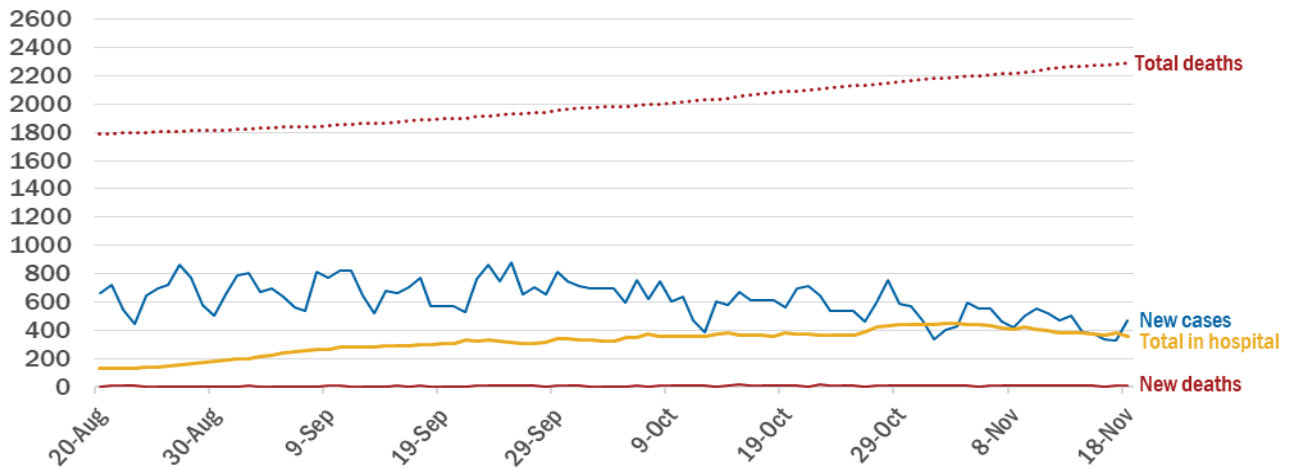

COVID-19 CASES AND DEATHS IN BC

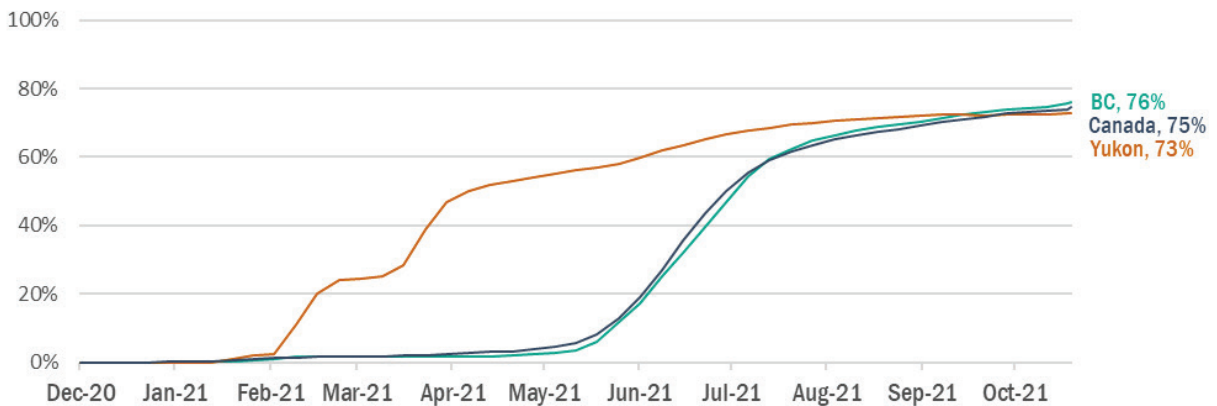


Note: Counts have been averaged where one number was reported for multi-day periods.

COVID-19 CASES AND DEATHS IN BC – PAST THREE MONTHS



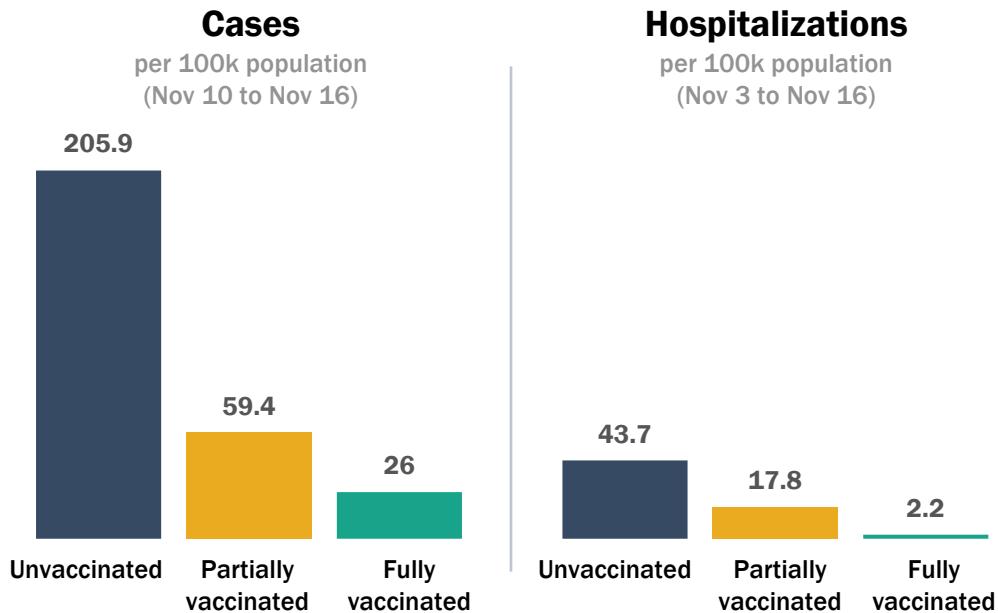
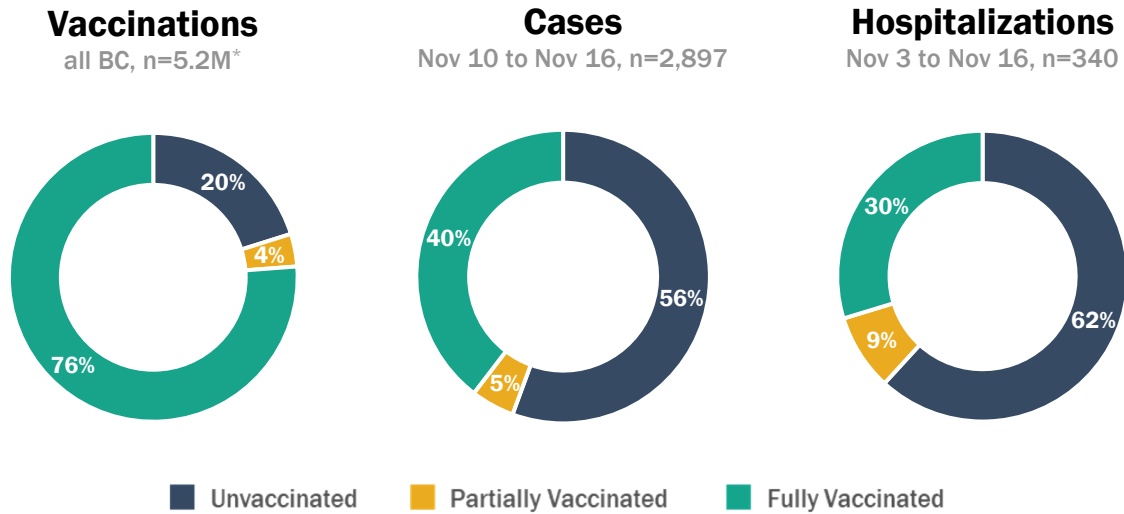
CUMULATIVE % OF PEOPLE FULLY VACCINATED WITH A COVID-19 VACCINE⁴

COVID-19 INFECTIONS IN B.C. BY VACCINATION STATUS

- From November 10 to November 16, 2021, people not fully vaccinated accounted for 60.4% of cases, and from November 3 to November 16, 2021, they accounted for 70.3% of hospitalizations.^{5,6}
