




#### **COVID-19 CASES AND DEATHS IN BC**



#### CUMULATIVE % OF PEOPLE FULLY VACCINATED WITH A COVID-19 VACCINE<sup>4</sup>






## **COVID-19 INFECTIONS IN B.C. BY VACCINATION STATUS**

• From November 24 to November 30, 2021, people not fully vaccinated accounted for 57.9% of cases, and from November 17 to November 30, 2021, they accounted for 68.1% of hospitalizations. 5,6
