**The 2024 TCG Archaeological Training program will include classroom and field-based learning. Students will acquire skills and information on the following:**

- Archaeological site identification
- Archaeological inventory techniques
- Recording archaeological sites
- Artifact analysis
- Artifact cataloguing
- Accessioning artifacts into a repository
- The implications of archaeology for Tahltan Rights and Title
- Archaeological overview and impact assessment process
- Archaeological site mitigation
- Representing the Tahltan Central Government on archaeological projects

Field visits will include hiking and being outdoors all day. Classroom activities will include working with artifacts collected at archaeological site IaTr-3 during last year's field training.

Students who successfully complete the course will be given priority for dispatch on upcoming archaeological opportunities with TCG occurring in the respective Tahltan Territory.

Ten spots available with priority given to in-territory members. Part-time to full-time Archaeology Monitor positions will be available in Tahltan Territory for successful candidates. Work will be physically demanding and require working in a camp setting for one to two weeks at a time.
